Opening Remarks:

- Heather Clark, PCMH Project Manager, welcomed everyone.

Discussion Items:

1. Review of Quality Measure Information

- Workgroup members reviewed the *Idaho's Initial Performance Measure Catalog* handout.

Yvonne Ketchum made a motion to leave the *Idaho's Initial Performance Measure Catalog* in-tact, as is, and should be measured as quality performance goals. Dr. Hahn seconded the motion. Motion passed.

After further review of *Idaho's Initial Performance Measure Catalog* Workgroup members agreed to change the word schizophrenia (HEDIS) to psychotic diagnoses on page two.

Yvonne Ketchum made a motion to amend the motion by striking out ~~to leave the *Idaho's Initial Performance Measure Catalog* in-tact, as is,~~ and insert to accept the *Idaho's Initial Performance Measure Catalog* with changes to the Measure, Adherence to antipsychotics for individuals with schizophrenia (HEDIS). It should instead state, Adherence to antipsychotics for individuals with psychotic diagnoses.

2. Tasks:

- The Idaho Health Data Exchange (IHDE) has requested a list of Idaho's performance measures that will be reported by clinics that are using electronic health records (EHRs).

3. Finalize recommendations:

- Final recommendations by the Workgroup members are listed below:
 - Screening for clinical depression – EHR
 - Tobacco use assessment and tobacco cessation intervention (SIM) – EHR
 - Asthma Emergency Department (ED) visits – Hospital
 - Acute care hospitalization (risk-adjusted) – Hospital
 - Readmission rate within 30 days – Hospital
 - Avoidable emergency care without hospitalization (risk-adjusted) – Hospital
 - Elective delivery – Hospital
 - Low birth weight rate (PQI9) – Hospital & Vital Records
 - Adherence to antipsychotics for individuals with psychotic diagnoses – EHR
 - Weight assessment and counseling for children and adolescents (SIMS) – EHR
 - Comprehensive diabetes care (SIMS) – EHR
 - Access to care – Patient survey
 - Childhood immunizations – EHR and IRIS
 - Adult BMI assessment – EHR
 - Non-malignant opioid use – EHR and pharmacy
