<p>Preventive Care and Screening: Tobacco Use: Screening and Cessation Intervention</p> <p>CMS 138v4, PQRS 226, NQF 0028</p>	<p>Percentage of patients aged 18 years and older who were screened for tobacco use one or more times within 24 months AND who received cessation counseling intervention if identified as a tobacco user.</p>
<p>Weight Assessment and Counseling for Nutrition and Physical Activity for Children and Adolescents</p> <p>CMS 155v4, PQRS 239, NQF 0024</p>	<p>Percentage of patients 3-17 years of age who had an outpatient visit with a Primary Care Physician (PCP)* or Obstetrician / Gynecologist (OB/GYN) and who had evidence of the following during the measurement period. Three rates are reported:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Percentage of patients with height, weight, and body mass index (BMI) percentile documentation • Percentage of patients with counseling for nutrition • Percentage of patients with counseling for physical activity <p><i>*This measure includes all providers such as Physicians, Physician Assistants, and Nurse Practitioners in Family Medicine, Primary Care Medicine, General Practice Medicine, Pediatric Medicine, or Obstetrician/Gynecologist (OB/GYN) Medicine. The data is collected based on procedures conducted rather than the type of provider.</i></p>
<p>Preventive Care and Screening: Adult Body Mass Index (BMI) Screening and Follow-Up Plan</p> <p>CMS 69v4, PQRS 128, NQF 421</p>	<p>Percentage of patients aged 18 years and older with a BMI documented during the current encounter or during the previous six months AND with a BMI outside of normal parameters, a follow-up plan is documented during the encounter or during the previous six months of the current encounter.</p>
<p>Diabetes: Hemoglobin A1c Poor Control</p> <p>CMS 122v4, PQRS 001, NQF 0059</p>	<p>Percentage of patients 18-75 years of age with diabetes who had hemoglobin A1c > 9% during the measurement period.</p>
