- ❖ Scott Carrell welcomed the members. The HIT members introduced themselves. Minutes of the 8/19/2014 HIT Workgroup meeting were accepted as prepared.
- ❖ State Purchasing Requirements – Peg Dougherty, Deputy Attorney General
 - As issues arise, Peg would be happy to answer questions.
 - Use the information provided in the PowerPoint slides as the framework for planning in the event the grant is awarded.
 - Refer to the PowerPoint presentation for statutory references.
- ❖ SHIP Update – Denise Chuckovich, Deputy Director – Health & Welfare
 - Denise provided the SHIP Model Test Proposal timeline.
 - The two SHIP goals related to Health Information Technology are:
 - Improve care through adoption and use of EHRs and connection to IHDE.
 - Build a statewide data analytics system that provides quality feedback to the provider, region and state.
 - The three SHIP contracts related to HIT are:
 - PCMH Performance Reporting Training and Technical Assistance
 - IHDE Expansion and Connections
 - Data Collection and Analytics
 - These three Core Quality Measures will be looked at the first year:
 - Tobacco use assessment and intervention
 - Weight assessment and counseling for children and adolescents
 - Comprehensive diabetes care
 - Denise offered two suggestions:
 - The HIT Workgroup may want to discuss the value of splitting into two workgroups.
 - IHDE Contract Workgroup
 - Data Analytics Workgroup
 - Invite Dr. Baron to attend the next meeting as a subject matter expert re: quality measures.
 - It is important to link quality measures, HIT, and Data Analytics.
- ❖ Data Analytics – Scott Carrell, IHDE
 - Model Design - The manner in which PCMH can gain access and share data is a key component.
 - Data Sharing, Interconnectivity, Analytics and Reporting
 - Scott will update the flow chart to a circular flow diagram.
 - A fifth box labeled Data Entry will be added with bullets QC and Timing.
 - A QC bullet will be added to the Analysis box.
 - Identify who the consumers are and what reports will be needed.
 - The updated diagram will be presented as the next deliverable to the IHC.
