### **Visit Objectives:**

The team will gain an understanding of:

1. Health System Perspective
  - a. How the health systems use the HIE as part of a workflow. Any technologies leveraged to increase integration.
  - b. How interoperability has been addressed in the health system with the HIE.
  - c. How health systems and ACOs utilize the HIE for population health and care management.
  - d. How payers leverage the HIE. How payments to providers are impacted.
2. HIE Product Perspective
  - a. Financial sustainability and capital investment process for a successful HIE.
  - b. Pricing model for analytics provisioning
  - c. How the data quality improvement process is conducted with clinic and health systems.
  - d. File formats leveraged for clinical quality data; advantages and disadvantages operationally with using these.
  - e. Current structure and staffing allocation of the HIE team.
  - f. Vision for utilization of emerging technological approaches (i.e. APIs, FHIR, Direct, Commonwell, etc.)
  - g. How the organizational hierarchy / provider directories is built and maintained.
  - h. Attribution methodology and how this is operationalized.
3. Stakeholder Participation and Governance Perspective
  - a. Understanding of the historic process used to create the governance group, data quality group and other supporting stakeholder groups; including samples of various charters, composition/listservs.
  - b. Strategies for engaging stakeholders and getting to a shared state vision.
  - c. Gaining an understanding of the lessons learned and potential gaps in the process (i.e. CQM reporting, attribution, etc.)
