

## Idaho SAN Grant

CMS-CMMI Transforming Clinical Practice Initiative – Idaho Update – 10-14-15

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- FOA Support and Alignment (SAN) and Practice Transformation Network (PTN) posted by CMS 10-23-14
- PTN announced at \$670m, 35 awards, \$2m to \$50m, four years
- SAN announced at \$30m, 30 awards, \$1m to \$3m, four years
- Applications due 1-6-15, later delayed to 2-5-15
- Anticipated NOA date 4-10-15
- IHC asks IPCA to apply in partnership with IDHW, IAFP, IMA and the request is accepted
  - IPCA submits letter of interest 11-20-14
  - IPCA submits the application at just under \$3m
  - IPCA, IDHW, IAFP, IMA begin work on enabling MOA, to create 'Idaho Center for Healthcare Transformation – ICHT'. Got to joint draft and paused
- NOA date pushed back – Spring 2015, Spring/early Summer, late Summer, late September
- SAN awards announced – 10 grantees

  - ◆ National Nursing Centers Consortium
- Review of FOA – no indication of intent to only award to grantees with national footprints, with specific evidence to the contrary

### PTN

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- PTN grant submitted and later withdrawn by St. Luke's Health Partners; Portneuf?
- PTN awards announced – 29 grantees
- Idaho named in two PTN grants (per CMMI web page) – University of Washington (WWAMI States) and Community Health Center Association of Connecticut (nationwide).
