PROPOSAL

Activities of the Population Health Workgroup:

- Advise the Idaho Healthcare Coalition and the Regional Collaboratives on population health, both within the patient centered medical home and in the medical/health neighborhoods to achieve the 80% population requirement of CMMI
 - Gina W. – getting at the 3 buckets through PCMH and RHCs together? Yes
 - 55 practices/yr x 3 will not get to 80%. Population health will get us there
 - Lora W. – How will we capture the others? Elke-this is exactly what this WG needs to figure out. How can we capture PH work and the #s served.
 - Neva – How will we know if we have reached 80% of pop? Do HDs capture this? Elke-no, we do not know this right now. Original was 60 practices/yr which would be 80% but when we had to cut back, we still had to hit 80%
 - Chris H. – what does reach mean? If education is part, then we can get some of that. Immunization rates, etc. **Elke – for next time bring back what CMMI means.**
- Advise other workgroups of the Idaho Healthcare Coalition on population health
 - What does population health mean? For us, it is everyone in the state not on a registry or within the reach of an ACO.
 - This group establishes this and takes it back to IHC
 - Neva – will someone from this group be on each WG to keep population health in the forefront? Elke-up to each, i.e. Jeff C. back to payer WG. Hopes to have DHW staff on all WGs.

- Identify opportunities for public health and primary care integration within the Regional Collaboratives that can positively impact SHIP success
