Idaho Foodbank	Idaho Foodbank will discuss the intersection of food insecurity and the medical community <i>(Handout) Karen Vauk presented on the Idaho Foodbank. The Foodbank is a statewide organization that is committed to supporting population health through addressing the issues of food insecurity and poverty in Idaho. Karen's presentation highlighted the statistics in Idaho of who needs and uses the Foodbank's resources.</i> <i>The Foodbank has been working towards identifying why 1 in 6 Idahoans live with food insecurity and how they can help prevent food insecurity. This work has included partnering with several other organizations committed to helping Idahoans throughout the state. The Idaho Foodbank works with these outside organizations to provide preventive care to Idahoans who are living in poverty or food insecurity.
