Live Better Website	The Idaho Live Better website will be reviewed Dieuwke Dizney-Spencer presented on the Live Better Idaho website. An effort throughout the Department of Health and Welfare to try and be more user friendly on how the department represents itself to the public. Greg Koonz helped put together the site to simplify it and make it easy for users to access the website. The want was for the website to go beyond the department and get several kinds of resources established. The website also incorporates different methods to help users. IT is built to help users discover what they need help with and what programs they are eligible for. Covers basic information on welfare programs and helps users to apply to programs they are most likely eligible. The Department now has the Idaho Wellness Guide, Live Better Idaho; these will help with community outreach and connecting with those who need assistance in the community. 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	<p>Mary Sheridan presented on the status of work on the CHEMS, CHW and Telehealth projects are at. CHEMS is becoming a workgroup and meets weekly. Mary will be presenting the CHEMS measures at the May IHC meeting. There are five categories; Quality of life, Reduction in Emergency Doctor visits, Connecting savings to lowered number of Emergency Doctors' visits, Connection with Primary Care Providers, looking at medication discrepancies. CHEMS is now a workgroup and will need to work to clarify measures and data collection methods. Identifying a basic education background and establishing new Telehealth programs are a main focus for the workgroup. Get referrals from several resources in the department.</p> <p>CHW is working on a contract with Idaho State University to adopt and use. The CHW advisory group wants to offer the first CHW course in September, each course will be taught by a pair of instructors.</p> <p>Telehealth is currently trying to procure a contract to receive technical assistant. There is a lot of interest in Telehealth around the state.</p>		
CDC 6 18 Initiative	<p>Present the CDC Initiative</p> <p>Elke presented on the CDC's 6 18 Initiative it is an initiative that aligns with the three buckets that the workgroup has discussed in prior meetings. This initiative focuses more on clinics and not communities and looks at an integrated healthcare framework. As we move forward and thinking about the Medical Health Neighborhood it might help to start looking at these interventions.</p> <p>Public Health 3.0 is a new initiative that the CDC is looking at, there are five cities selected by CDC across the US that they are having talks about this initiative. The closest one to Boise will be in Spokane on July 11th. Idaho has been encouraged to send people to this meeting.
