



Idaho Telehealth 101

In May of 2018, the Department of Health and Welfare partnered with the Idaho Healthcare Coalition to work with 8 Idaho clinics and 1 CHEMs agency to support new telehealth programs that improve care, increase access to care, expand system capacity, and achieve efficiencies in health care delivery.
